

Remote Learning Contingency Plan for ongoing Teaching and Learning

Tier 1 Scenarios (school is fully open)	Teaching and learning response
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Individual pupils are self-isolating 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Work will be set through Edulink in the first instance ▪ Some work may be done through Microsoft Teams but this will be indicated through Edulink ▪ Pupils are advised to follow the same routines as school and work through the set work as per their timetable ▪ In some instances it may be appropriate for some pupils to join lessons through Teams. If this is the case pupils will receive a message through Edulink
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Groups of pupils are self-isolating 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students who are in school will be taught their normal timetable. There may be some collapsing of smaller classes in school to enable some live lessons for the pupils that are self-isolating ▪ Students who are self-isolating will be provided with a timetable with a blend of live lessons, where the timetable allows, and work to be done independently.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Whole year group self-isolating 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students in this year group will follow their normal school timetable through Microsoft Teams. ▪ Most of this timetable will be live lessons. However, there may be instances where recorded lessons or assignment work are more appropriate. All information regarding this will be posted in Microsoft Teams.
Tier 2 Scenario (secondary schools are asked to operate a rota system for year groups)	Teaching and learning response
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A rota is in place, some year groups will be in school whilst some year groups will be taught remotely 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Year groups that are in school will follow their normal timetable ▪ For year groups that are working remotely most of this timetable will be live lessons. However, there may be instances where recorded lessons or assignment work are more appropriate. All information regarding this will be posted in Microsoft Teams.
Tier 3 and 4 Scenarios (secondary schools are asked to limit on-site attendance)	Teaching and learning response
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ For Tier 3 attendance some year groups may be prioritised. At this stage we will be informed by guidance issued by the government. ▪ For Tier 4 School is closed to all pupils apart from those pupils that are vulnerable or have parents that are key workers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All year groups will work remotely as directed by DfE ▪ Pupils will follow their normal timetable remotely ▪ Most of this timetable will be live lessons. However, there may be instances where recorded lessons or assignment work are more appropriate. All information regarding this will be posted in Microsoft Teams.
