



Dear Parent/Carer,

On the final run up to the GCSEs, we always put in extra support for our students to help them achieve their full potential and to feel confident with the exam series they face in the coming weeks.

As such, our staff have given up their time over the Easter holiday to run several, targeted master classes for many different subjects.

The individual student timetables for the master classes were given out to parents in the packs at the revision launch, have been sent home with the students and are also on Edulink (in documents).

We do expect pupils to attend as we know that 'running the extra mile' has a huge impact not only on student confidence but also the crucial development of their knowledge, skills, application and understanding for the examinations.
